Covid-19 Protection Framework Health & Safety Protocol for Users "Red" Level Last Updated 24 March 2022



Ko te Hapori tō mātou Pokapū Community is at our Centre

The Glenfield Community Centre is open for hire and open to the public under all levels of the Covid-19 Protection Framework ("Traffic Light System" or "TLS"), with restrictions. These restrictions are detailed below and take effect from **Saturday 26 March 2022**.

Key Principles:

- Under the TLS (Traffic Light System), the Centre is considered a "Public Facility."
- Only groups or individuals with Covid-19 vaccination certificates can access our facility and should have them ready to be checked if requested. After April 4 vaccine certificates are no longer required.
- All persons are **no longer required** to scan-in using the QR Code or use the manual record slips provided.
- Users/ Tenants remain responsible for the health and safety of participants within their group or booking and ensuring their participants are aware of the current Level Health and Safety Covid-19 Protocols.
- Attendance records must be kept by hire coordinators on the sheets provided.
- Mask wearing in communal areas (such as hallways, foyers, toilets), remains mandatory (unless medically exempt or under the age of 12) under the red and orange settings.
- Persons must maintain 1-metre distancing at all times. No congregating in communal areas (e.g., the courtyard).
- No one who is sick has been tested and is self-isolating or experiencing symptoms of Covid-19 is allowed on the premises. This includes persons who are a close contact awaiting a test result or have otherwise been asked to stay home until cleared by a medical professional.
- Maximum capacity at the Centre for any event/ gathering/ function is 200 persons.
 Confirm room capacities with our Administration Team when booking as these vary by Alert Level.
- Maintain airflow in spaces by opening windows, doors and using the wall/ pedestal fans provided.
- You are required to use the supplied disinfectant spray to clean all touch surfaces before you leave. This includes bathrooms, tables and chairs, light switches, and door handles.
- Our kitchen will remain closed at Red Level so please encourage people to bring their own water bottles.
- Please encourage everyone to follow good practice, cough, and sneeze into their elbows, sanitise their hands or wash them thoroughly.
- All users, clients and class participants are required to **report any risk of Covid-19 infection** to our Administration Team as soon as it is recognised.

By hiring the Glenfield Community Centre, you (the Hirer) accept these Covid-19 related conditions of hire, warrant and confirm to abide by all rules and directives published and updated by the Government from time to time at <u>https://covid19.govt.nz/</u>.
